

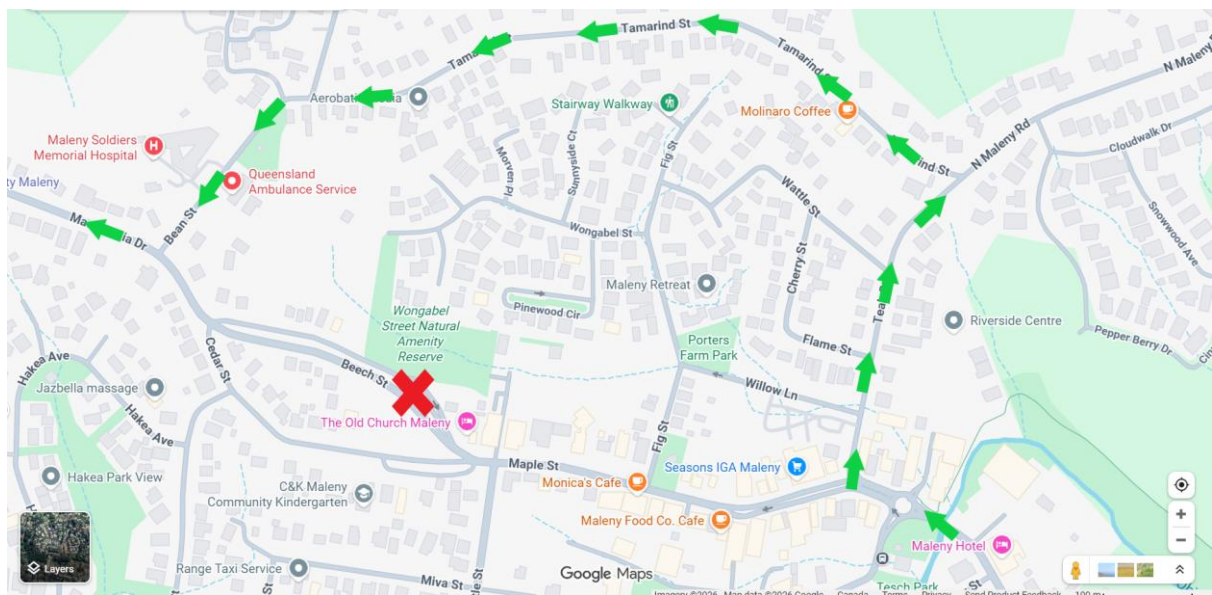
Hi [Full Name],

The Sunshine Coast Motorcycle Club would like to welcome you to Classic Weekend, which is being run 5-7 June.

The event Supplementary Regulations, a guide on how to purchase a licence through Ridernet, and a map of the site and a timetable have been attached to this email.

## ROAD CLOSURE

Due to major road works in Maleny, Beech Street has been closed and there is a detour in place. Anyone driving through Maleny will need to use Teak Street / Tamarind Street / Bean Street to navigate the closed road.



## VENUE OPEN

Gates will open at 7:00am on Friday morning – **do not arrive before this time, cars queuing out on to the road is unsafe**. Please bring your receipt to the gate – this allows you into the event without paying the \$20 spectator fee.

## SIGN ON

Sign on will be open at the Control Tower from 8:00am Friday morning – you must sign on before any riding; to maximise your ride time come and visit us on Friday to get checked in. A mandatory Rider's Briefing will be held at 8:30am at the Control Tower on both Saturday and Sunday morning. Medics will be at the Control Tower from midday Friday, (and overnights) until Sunday afternoon.

Any pre-purchased raffle tickets can be collected from the Control Tower; there will also be more raffle tickets available for purchase at the event.

## LICENCES

There are still a number of people who do not have a current licence, and have not purchased a One Event Recreational licence – these need to be purchased through Ridernet; a list of riders without licences is below. Riders without a licence cannot ride – please make sure you have a licence before arrival. **No licence = no riding.**

## EQUIPMENT

**Tear offs cannot be used at this venue** – please remember to bring your roll offs. If you are planning on riding the Grass Track over the weekend you will need a trials type tyre on the rear, and you **must have a back protector**. All motocross and enduro riders will also require body armour.

## CAMPING

Please consider others when you are setting up your camping/pit site, as other riders will be looking for parking space. The bar closes at 10:30pm and all noise is to be kept to a minimum after this time due to noise curfews – please remember we have close neighbours to our venue.

Any campfires at the event **MUST** be contained in an off-ground fire bucket; there are to be no fires directly on the ground (this is a requirement of Sunshine Coast Council), and no rocks are to be surrounding fires. You will need to bring your fire buckets with you, there are no spare fire buckets available at the venue.

## RIDING RESTRICTIONS

Riding on pit bikes, ebikes, balance bikes, scooters, ATV's, bicycles etc at this event is not permitted, and no spectators are permitted to ride on any of these vehicles.

## FOOD AND DRINKS

A canteen will be available to buy food from midday Friday throughout the event until after lunch on Sunday, and is run by the local Conondale P&C – we appreciate your support to the local community. The club have our own coffee machine, and coffee will be available from early Friday morning at the bar. The Poffertjes van will also be available with delicious dutch pancakes over the weekend.

## BE RESPECTFUL OF OTHER RIDERS

Classic Weekend is a recreational event – it is not a competition day. There may be riders on the tracks with varying skill levels, please be respectful of those around you – dangerous riding will not be tolerated.

## VENUE INFO

Glass bottles are not permitted at this venue (this is a requirement of Sunshine Coast Council) – that means no stubbies or wine bottles. **Any glass will be confiscated.**

When you are leaving the venue, please make sure that the area is clean and rubbish free, there will be skips around the venue for your rubbish. As you enter the venue, you will receive a garbage bag – if you run out during the event please come and grab another one from us at the Control Tower.

Please respect all of our volunteers and officials helping to run our events, without all of their support we can't continue to operate – there's no excuse for abuse. We also ask that you respect our neighbours and local communities, we have had a number of issues with late night noises (bikes being ridden after curfew, illegal fireworks etc) that cannot continue. These kind of stunts put the club and our lease at risk – If you want to keep riding at our track in the future, please use your common sense and be courteous to everyone around you.
