Capacity and fuel testing may be utilised by the Scrutineer at any round to assist with machine eligibility.

Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

## 15. RIDING NUMBERS:

The circuit is natural terrain with grass covering and left and right hand corners. The distance is approx. 493m long and 6-8m wide.

## 27. RESTRICTIONS:

- Riders must seek permission from the Clerk of Course in writing prior to the start of the event that the change of machine is required for. Failure to seek permission may incur a penalty. Second machines must have passed machine examination.
- Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- BACK NUMBERS MUST be worn by all riders Junior and Senior (visually seen) and MUST match Bike Number.
- All competitive Junior riders must have (and bring) their logbooks to the event; and must also hold appropriate endorsements for the bikes they are riding.
- Senior riders must hold either a Senior National Licence, or a One Event Competition Licence.
- Junior competitive riders must hold either a a Junior National Licence, or a One Event Competition Licence. Junior riders must also be appropriately endorsed.
- Junior non competition class riders must hold either a Mini Licence, Recreational Licence, or a One Event Recreational Licence. The Junior non competition class is not open to riders with competition licences.
- All bikes must have numbers - one on the front and one on each side.
- All riders must be wearing a back protector as per 17.1.4 A) "A commercially manufactured back protector, except where suits/jackets are fitted with integral back protection. Protection of the back must be continuous and cover all of the back area between the collar and the base of the spine."

- If the rider has their own transponder(s), the transponder hire fee will not be applicable. The rider must advise the correct transponder number(s) applicable.

- Electronic timing is compulsory for all competitors.
- Transponders **MUST** be fitted for all practice and racing.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is mounted correctly and securely.
- All competitors are to provide their MA licence (or similar) in exchange for a transponder.
- When a hired transponder is transferred to the competitor, it then becomes the competitor's responsibility.
- Transponders must be returned before competitors vacate the venue.
- For transponders not returned on the same day, late fees may be charged. Late fees will be charged at \$20 per day, per transponder. Some leeway may be given in special circumstances.
- Loss or damage of transponders will incur a replacement fee.

### **30. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:**

All competitors should have a minimum 2kg, dry power A: B (E) class, working fire extinguishers in their pit area.
