The Sunshine Coast Motorcycle Club would like to welcome you to our MX RPA day being held at Conondale this Sunday (18/1/26), and we thank you for taking the time to enter online.

For those of you who have not been to the track for a while, the club has put in a new entry road. You will be able to enter Green Park at the middle gate (between the old pit entry road, and the spectator entry road). The new road runs along the front boundary fence line and takes you over the front hill and down the back. The club will also have coffee available from the bar beside the canteen.

Sign on will be completed electronically – any riders under 18 must have a parent or guardian accompany them to sign on. Sign on will be open from 6:30am until 8:00am, please make sure you are on time so we can get everyone on track without delays. Riders briefing will be from 8:00am, and it is mandatory for riders and their parent/guardian to attend with them. Camping is available on Saturday night only.

RPA PASSES

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

CAMPING

Please consider others when you are setting up your camping/pit site, as other riders will be looking for parking space. Camping is available on Saturday night only. If you are camping at the track there are to be NO FIRES. **Any vehicles without bikes must park in the spectator parking area in the centre.** Children must return to their campsite by 8:30pm and noise is to be kept to a minimum after this time. Generators must be turned off at 10:00pm and are not to be restarted until 5:30am.

BICYCLES

There are to be no electric bicycles, balance bikes, bicycles, scooters etc to be used at the track. Any riders on motorcycles must be wearing protective gear (including helmet) and at walking speed. No doubling and no wheelies on any vehicles.

A canteen run by the Conondale State School P&C will be available on Sunday for breakfast and lunch – we appreciate your support for our local community.

All riders please ensure that when you leave the venue that the area is rubbish free. Tear offs and glass bottles are not permitted at this venue – any tear offs found on rider's goggles will be confiscated. Roll off systems are encouraged.

Dogs are not permitted at this venue by order of Motorcycling Australia and Sunshine Coast Council – please leave your furry friends at home.
