1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Sunshine Coast MCC hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct Caloundra Motorcycles Pony Express 2024 Enduro at the 1156 Maleny Kenilworth Road, on 24-Aug-24 to 25-Aug-24 as per Permit Applications applied for.

2. JURISDICTION:

The above mentioned event has been authorised by Motorcycling Queensland (MQLD) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number EN/24/O/12921 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia licences.

The event will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling QLD. By entering this Event all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

If an International Meeting Number (IMN) is approved, competitors with comparable licenses from another FMN who have obtained written clearance and provide verification of personal FIM insurance to a standard accepted by Motorcycling Australia are also eligible to compete.

3. ENTRIES:

Entries open forthwith and close on 22-Aug-24 via Ridernet. Conditions of entries in section 27.

In the case of postponement or abandonment of the event, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Sunshine Coast MCC, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling QLD. Only entries received on the official Entry Form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4. INSURANCE:

National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

Best Medical will be in attendance prior to any on track motorcycle activity until 15 minutes after the completion of racing each day.

The event is an Enduro Pony Express, for junior and senior competition licence holders. Juniors will have 1 guided sighting lap, followed by 3 hours of competition. Seniors will have 5 hours of competition.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the event will be deemed to be 06:00 AM with the completion of the event for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

Enduro Events - Prior to competition there may be an escorted preliminary lap of the course.

Track dissatisfaction - Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of the Course. If those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the event.

12. AWARDS AND PRIZE MONEY:

Awards will be presented after the completion of racing.

13. PRESENTATION:

Presentation will be held after the completion of racing.

14. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Enduro Competition.

Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the event.

It is the competitor or parent / legal guardians' responsibility to ensure that any machine that suffers accident damage during practice or racing is repaired and will meet the required safety standards as outlined in the MOMS prior to further participation in the event.

Capacity and fuel testing may be utilised by the Scrutineer at any round to assist with machine eligibility.

Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

15. RIDING NUMBERS:

Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's for Enduro.

16. GRID POSITIONS:

NA. Starts will be a mass Le Mans start, by class.

17. RIDER'S BRIEFING:

A rider's briefing will be held at 10:00 AM and prior to any on track motorcycle activity. It is compulsory for ALL competitors to attend. A random attendance roll call may be utilised by the Clerk of Course to determine a competitor's attendance at rider's briefing. The Clerk of Course may at his/her discretion, penalise any competitor who is called randomly at riders briefing and is proven not to be in attendance by not responding to that call.

Smoking is strictly prohibited at Rider's Briefing.

18. STARTS:

19. TYRES:

As per GCR 10.20.9.1 Metal studs, spikes, chain, rope or other non-skid attachments, as well as paddle or scoop treaded tyres may not be used.

20. ANTI-DOPING POLICY:

All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.

Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements they should visit the website www.sportintegrity.gov.au

It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are known.

21. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Safety Policy - Drug and Alcohol testing.

22. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated on the MA website - www.ma.org.au) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Events. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Event and will be enforced.

23. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Electronic Communications and Social Media Policy (in supp regs) / Social Media Policy (on website), found at www.ma.org.au, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behaviour where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons.

24. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR:

All competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behaviour contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at www.ma.org.au which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race events. These Codes of Behaviour apply to this event and will be enforced. If a rider is banned from entry at one of the participating rounds/venues, they will not be allowed to participate in that round of the series.

25. SOUND/NOISE TESTING:

Sound Testing may be conducted as per the GCR's.

26. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

The track is natural terrain. The tracks will be approximately 20km for the seniors, and 12km for the juniors.

27. RESTRICTIONS:

- Junior competition will be on Saturday. - Senior competition will be on Sunday.
- There will be no change of machinery once racing has commenced.
- Teams may have 2 riders and 2 machines, or 2 riders and 1 machine. Ironman entrants may only have 1 rider and 1 machine.
- Teams must have a transponder fitted to the bike that is on track. Failure to fit a transponder to the correct bike will result in no lap(s) being recorded for that team.
- For teams, the times will be added together to determine the winner; the team with the total lowest time will be placed 1st and so on.

28. SPECTATOR FEE'S AND INFORMATION:

There is no fee for attending spectators.

29. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- There will be no late entries; all entries will be taken through Ridernet.
- **No glass** bottles are permitted at Green Park.
- **Tear offs are not permitted** at Green Park; roll off systems are encouraged.
- **No dogs** are permitted by order of Motorcycling Australia and Sunshine Coast Council. Guide and Assistance Dogs excepted.
- There are no open fires permitted at Green Park. All fires must be in a fire container off the ground, and there are to be **NO ROCKS** surrounding fires.
- Electronic sign on will be used at this event; you must attend sign on. Under 18's must attend with a parent/guardian.
- Completed self scrutineering forms must be bought to sign on.
- Electronic timing is compulsory for all competitors. Transponder hire will be charged at \$20 each, and must be fitted for practice and racing.
- All competitors are to provide their MA licence (or similar) in exchange for a transponder. Transponders must be returned before competitors leave the venue; transponders not returned on the same day may

incur late fees charged at \$20 per day. Some leeway may be given in special circumstances.

- Loss or damage of transponders will incur a replacement fee.
- Children must return to their campsite by 8:30pm, and noise is to be kept to a minimum after this time. Generators must be turned off at 10:00pm and are not to be restarted until 5:30am.
- Entrants wishing to withdraw from the event **MUST** notify the Race Secretary before 4pm 28/8/24 to be eligible for a refund.

30. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:

All competitors should have a minimum 2kg, dry power A: B (E) class, working fire extinguishers in their pit area.
