The Sunshine Coast Motorcycle Club would like to welcome you to our Grass Track RPA day being held at Conondale this Sunday (22/2/26), and we thank you for taking the time to enter online.

For those of you who have not been to the track for a while, the club has put in a new entry road. The new road runs along the front boundary fence line. If you have not been to the Grass Track before, you'll need to follow the entry road around the back of the pits and cross the creek crossing to the flat track out the back.

Please remember that all bikes (larger than 85cc) must have a trials type tyre on the rear while riding on the Grass Track.

SIGN ON

Sign on will be completed electronically – any riders under 18 must have a parent or guardian accompany them to sign on. Sign on will be open from 7:00 until 8:15 am, please make sure you are on time so we can get everyone on track without delays. Riders briefing will be from 8:15am, and it is mandatory for riders and their parent/guardian (for those under 18) to attend with them.

RPA PASSES

All riders without a current annual MA licence must purchase the \$10 RPA Pass through Ridernet. You can add your RPA Pass on by editing your entry through Ridernet. If you are having issues doing so, please give me a call on 0402 585 472 to sort it out.

All riders please ensure that when you leave the venue that the area is rubbish free. Tear offs and glass bottles are not permitted at this venue – any tear offs found on rider's goggles will be confiscated. Roll off systems are encouraged.

Dogs are not permitted at this venue by order of Motorcycling Australia and Sunshine Coast Council – please leave your furry friends at home.
